daring us to do the same.

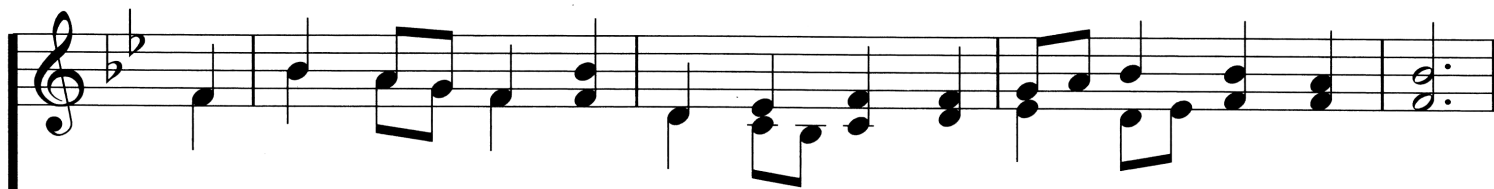

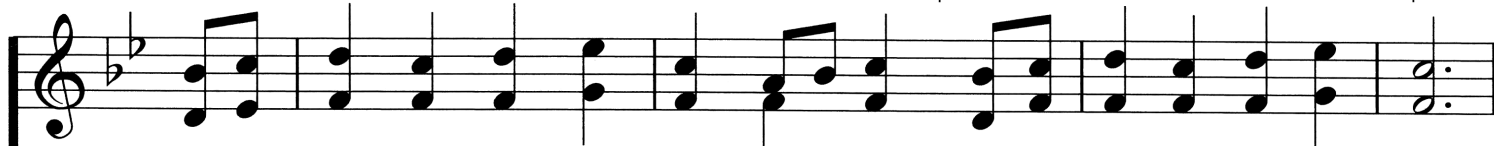
I Sing the Mighty Power of God

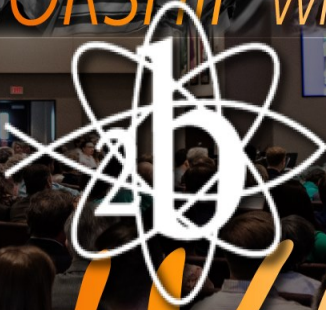
