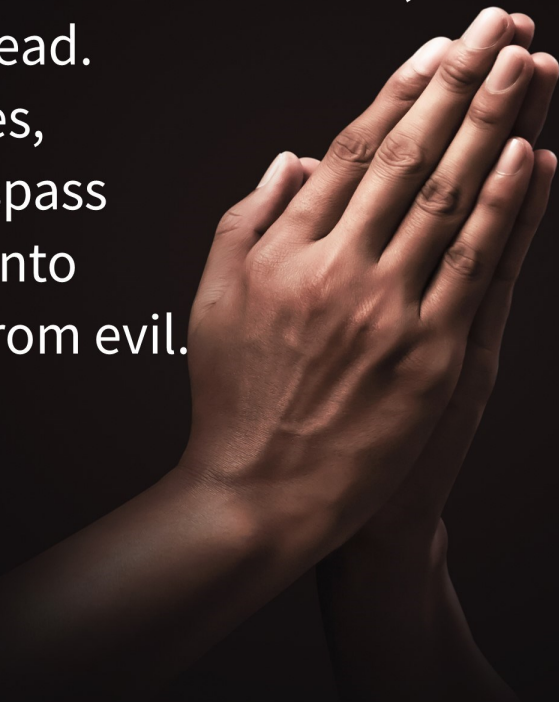
- Please come forward to take communion by exiting your row to your right.
