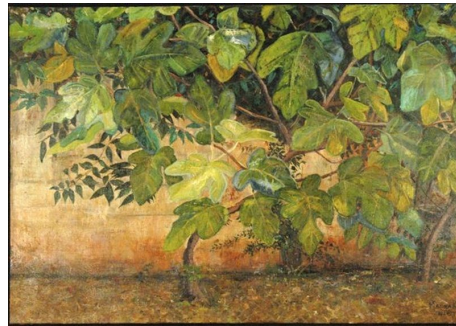




INVITATION TO CHRISTIAN DISCIPLESHIP




