¹⁸ Now the birth of Jesus the Messiah took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been engaged to Joseph, but before they lived together, she was found to be pregnant from the Holy Spirit. ¹⁹ Her husband Joseph, being a righteous man and unwilling to expose her to public disgrace, planned to divorce her quietly. ²⁰ But just when he had resolved to do this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, “Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife, for the child conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. ²¹ She will bear a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins.” ²² All this took place to fulfill what had been spoken by the Lord through the prophet: ²³ “Look, the virgin shall become pregnant and give birth to a son, and they shall name him Emmanuel,” which means, “God is with us.” ²⁴ When Joseph awoke from sleep, he did as the angel of the Lord commanded him; he took her as his wife ²⁵ but had no marital relations with her until she had given birth to a son, and he named him Jesus.

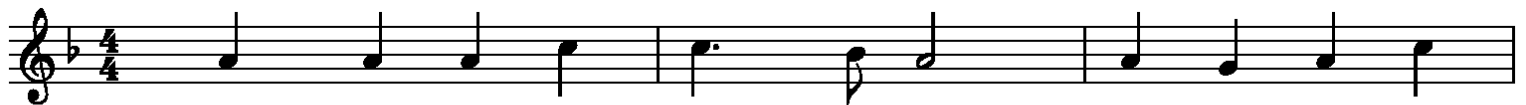

My name is Israel Rodriguez, Sr, and I have served as pastor of the First Baptist Church here in Piedras Negras, Coahuila, for over 36 years. Taking into account what God's word says, **"as you did unto these little ones,"** says the Lord, **"you did unto me."** 6 years ago the church decided to seek a ministry of those most in need. We began working with migrants offering accommodation and food which is most important to them. Along with that we offer the message of salvation. We believe it very important they know Christ. Whether they go to the United States or stay here, they can go with a different life because Christ is in their heart. There have been busy seasons with lots of hard work and slower times. At times we had 350 migrants in our two buildings. Other times like during the pandemic we have closer to 50 migrants staying with us. We provide a place to sleep and 2 meals a day. And we want them to know Christ as Savior. Beyond a place to sleep and eat, we also found these migrants come to us with many problems. Their families are split apart. They have emotional baggage. So we also offering a counseling ministry for psychological support in addition to the message of Christ as Savior.
